# Certified in Risk and Information Systems Control® (CRISC®) Examination Preparation Course

## Course Overview

The Certified in Risk and Information Systems Control (CRISC) Examination Preparation course is for IT and business professionals who identify and manage risks through the development, implementation and maintenance of appropriate information systems (IS) controls. The CRISC designation demonstrates to employers that the holder is able to identify and evaluate IT risk, and help their enterprise accomplish its business objectives. CRISC professionals help to affirm their business and IT risk management competence, and their ability to design, implement, monitor and maintain effective, risk-based information systems controls. The CRISC exam is offered three times a year (June, September, and December), consisting of 200 multiple-choice questions that cover the four CRISC domains
